## **WATER SHORTAGE**

**To Our Valued Residents:**

**We apologize for whatever inconveniences you may have experienced due to the lack of water for the past weeks, specially along Pasay Road, Acacia Road, portions of Paraiso Street and other adjoining streets.**

**According to Manila Water Co. Inc. (MWCI), the main water line along EDSA/Pasay Road was relocated to give way to the MRT Construction. After said relocation was completed the entry of surface water from Fort Bonifacio started decreasing registering very low water pressure. The water company is doing everything possible to increase the pressure at the Pasay Road entry point. We are constantly monitoring this problem.**

**In addition to the water problems described above, our village has had to contend with the delay in acceptance by MWCI of the newly renovated Amorsolo Reservoir. The Dasmarinas Village Association Inc. has invested a great deal of money to reactivate this reservoir. We are doing all possible to have the MWCI start operating this water source.**

**We have also addressed the problems encountered in the operation of Deep Well No. 16 which up to the present has not been operable due to the presence of sandy infiltration. It is hoped that the contractor Power Supply & Well Mgt. Corp. will find a solution to this problem.**

**Lastly, since yesterday, there has been a reduction of water pressure due to a massive leak in the water line from the La Mesa Dam which suffered damage in one of its valves.**

**Be assured that your Water Committee, with the able assistance of the DVA staff, is working hard to improve our water supply.**
