VILLAGE UPDATE

WATER - Despite the completion of the Amorsolo Reservoir, portions of Dasmarinas Village continue to experience occasional water shortage. This is unfortunate but relief is in sight.

Officials of the Manila Water Corp. Inc. assure us that a newly rehabilitated mini-booster pump, the 21st station located in East Rembo, Makati was completed last August 15, 2000. This station is operated on a 24-hour basis, 4 PM to 7 AM and 7 AM to 4 PM shifts.

Two pumping stations are now supplying water to our Village: the Fort Bonifacio Station and the Makati Pumping Station.

Our own deep wells are held in reserve and are activated as the need arises.

GARBAGE - We all know there is a serious garbage crisis without any solution in sight. It is therefore incumbent upon everyone to minimize the problem. Our garbage contractor, S.M. Coronado Service, is fielding 4 to 5 trucks daily. However, they are hard pressed to dispose of their cargo and the trips to the dumpsite take longer and requires careful scheduling.

Please implement these simple procedures:

- 1. Segregate kitchen waste;
- 2. Use a separate bag for recyclable waste;
- 3. Trim branches and tree cuttings for easy loading do not leave big branches which are bulky and cumbersome; and
- 4. Any other method which might help our collectors will be most welcome.

The Association gives a quarterly supply of garbage bags per house - please use these properly. Garbage bins and bags should be brought out between 7:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Garbage receptacles should be brought in by 7:00 a.m. everyday. Let us keep our sidewalks neat and clean.
