HALLOWEEN 2K CELEBRATION

Dear Residents:

A few days from now, Dasmarinas Village will hold its traditional Halloween celebration.

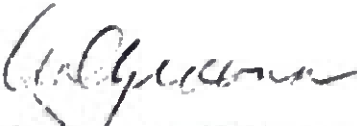
In the past years, the Village Association has implemented a policy of allowing trick or treating during Halloween exclusively for Dasmarinas Village residents only. Last year, however, there was a decision to include non-residents as well in the spirit of sharing with the less privileged. This move backfired on us due to some unruly groups of people who vandalized some houses (stealing Halloween decors) and pushing their way to get the treats. In the Barangay youth Halloween party, the decor and the treats were grabbed by the mob.

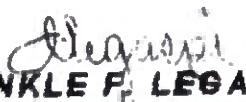
In view of the foregoing, we deem it necessary to institute some measures to prevent a repetition thereof. This can only be achieved if there is a semblance of order and discipline among the participants in the celebration. For this purpose, we are coming out with the following implementing guidelines:

- Participants to the Halloween celebration, including the trick or treating, shall be limited to the village residents and their guests and to the children of household helps, DVA and Barangay employees.
- Non-resident participants to the trick or treat or Halloween party organized by the Village Youth, should register with the Barangay office from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on October 28, 29 & 30, 2000. The Barangay shall issue an ID to the participants and which should be worn around their necks. NOTE: On Sunday, October 29, registration will be made at the Security office of DVA.
- Residents who wish to join the Halloween Party may call the Barangay office at 893-0215 or 812-3335 to register their children. (This is to ensure that there are enough loot bags for all who attend.)
- Non-resident children participating without ID shall be given a small treat and then escorted out of the Village by security personnel.
- All houses are requested to prepare treats for around 700 people. Trick or Treating will start at 4:00 P.M. ONLY. PLEASE DO NOT START DISTRIBUTING CANDIES BEFORE 4:00 P.M. A siren will signal the start of trick or treating.
- There will be a special box at the Security office on November 1 and 2 where residents can donate their excess candies from trick or treating with the poor.
- During the celebration, Campanilla and Calumpang and some smaller streets (Kalachuchi, Kalamansi, Kasoy, Kantas, Sinaguelas, Saman & Sagu) will be one way in order to ensure the smooth flow of traffic. A map will be given to all residents and signs will be placed on the affected streets.

We also wish to inform you that there is a contest for the house with the best Halloween decoration.
