VERY IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT PLEASE READ AND IMPLEMENT

Basura Ko, Pananagutan Ko!

As announced in a previous circular, the San Mateo Dumpsite will be closed on December 31, 2000. To this date the government has not found an alternative dumpsite. In view of this, Dasmarinas Village Association is strictly enforcing the Garbage Segregation Scheme effective January 1, 2001.

- I. Our garbage trucks will collect only the following bio-degradable or "nabubulok na basura" daily:
 - 1. Food and kitchen wastes (left-over food, vegetable and fruit peelings). Food and kitchen waste must be drained and free from liquid.
 - 2. Human and animal manure, dead insects and rats.
 - 3. Toilet paper, tissue, sanitary napkins. Disposable diapers can be included as long as the plastic portion is removed.
 - 4. Wet and very soiled newspaper and table napkins.
 - 5. Dried leaves.
- II. Grass and garden trimmings (other than leaves) will be collected separately two times a week - on Tuesdays and Fridays. Please bring out your garden trimmings only on Tuesdays and Fridays. Excessive garden cuttings will be collected upon prior arrangement with our village manager and for a fee.
- III. Non-biodegradable garbage Avail of our authorized junk buyers who go around the village everyday to buy/collect recyclable items. Make use of the yellow "RECYCLE" sign that we gave to all residents.
- IV. Our garbage collector will continue to pick up all kinds of garbage until December 30, 2000. So, if you have a lot of garbage accumulated from the holidays, be sure to throw them out NOW!

We thank the many interested residents who responded to our questionnaire on Waste Management last month. After the holidays, the DVA Subcommittee on Waste Management will conduct seminars for residents and household helpers on the proper way to dispose of garbage. In the meantime, we strongly advise everyone to
