GENERAL INFO & GENTLE REMINDERS

(To be read and digested before discarding)

Our village, fortunately, is populated by aware and concerned individuals. Thus a gentle nudge is sufficient to catch everyone's attention and cooperation. Here goes:

- **GARBAGE** – segregate, segregate, segregate. Please reread and discuss our poster on proper procedures with your family and staff. Our Village is so much cleaner and a little more effort will improve our garbage collection.
- **SIDEWALKS** - trash bins must be brought out for garbage collection no later than 2000 hours or 8:00 P.M. daily. The same receptacles must be brought in by 0800 or 8:00 A.M. the following morning. Please, no garbage cans should be left on the sidewalks or fronting houses.
- **DOGS** – many residents are disturbed when they see big dogs in small cages or dogs on a leash in the sun. Dogs may be animals but they are also man's best friend. Dogs that are tied whine or bark to be free. Treat your dogs humanely and your kindness will be repaid by your dog's faithfulness and loyalty.
- **WANTED** – a resident with expertise in computer networks to design a LAN system for the DVA office. Please contact our Village Manager, Mamerto R. Rodriguez.
- **VOTER EDUCATION** – a group of volunteers – Citizens of Makati for good governance will conduct a seminar to teach us to vote wisely. This will be held at the DVA Town Hall, **Tuesday, May 8 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** We encourage all Filipino voters to attend. Please give your household helpers time to attend.
- **ELECTIONS** – know your precinct before election day, May 14. You can check your precinct at the Barangay office or click on the Web to precinct.com – type your name to verify your precinct number and location.
- **SECURITY OFFICER** – we have hired Mr. Maribert Martin as a security officer to reinforce our services. Mr. Martin will, as a general rule, be on duty from 1600 hours or 4:00 P.M. until 2200 hours or 10:00 P.M. to cover the time when our Village Manager has gone home.
