RECYCLE

- * Bottles
- * Tin cans (lata)
- * Plastic
- * Paper (any kind)

For a less cluttered home, give away recyclables! Junk dealers will pick them any time you hang out the yellow "RECYCLE" sign given to DVA residents.





COMPOST

- Left-over food
- Kitchen waste
- * Grass
- * Leaves (not branches)

We encourage all households to compost garden waste. It is clean and the end product is "black gold" that will enrich your plants and garden.

If your have large amounts of garden waste in your yard, DVA can assist you in shredding leaves to facilitate composting. Separate large twigs and branches and tie together for pick up by the garbage collector.

GARBAGE PICK-UP

RESIDUALS - Anything that cannot be recycled and that you do not want to use for compost.

Good news for those who are squeamish about composting kitchen waste. Our garbage collector will pick it up and compost it. Be sure to put kitchen waste or wet garbage separately in a green garbage bag.

Effective July 15, 2001, Dasmarinas Village Association will give to all residents, free of charge, 90 (pcs.) green garbage bags and 60 (pcs.) black garbage bags quarterly.

GREEN BAGS — for wet garbage

BLACK BAGS – for dry garbage

Reminder: Garbage bins should be brought out not earlier than 8:00 p.m. and brought in not later than 7:00 a.m. daily. Remember to keep your sidewalks neat and clean!
