TRAFFIC SCHEME EFFECTIVE JUNE 16, 2003

Colegio San Agustin (CSA) will start its school year 2003-2004 on *Monday, June* 16, 2003.

Hence, the DVA Security & Traffic Committee, will implement the traffic scheme used for the past 2 years, which has been effective.

For the peak period from 6:00 to 8:00 A.M. and 2:00 to 5:00 P.M., Monday to Friday, designated one-way and parking zones are the following:

- ONE-WAY ZONES: <u>Lumbang Street from Carissa to Pasay Road and Carissa Street from Palm Avenue to Lumbang.</u> Other streets will be two-way.
- PARKING ZONES: Along portions of Lumbang & Carlssa Streets campus side.

During these hours residents are requested to use alternate routes. Proper signs will be placed in affected areas and MMDA-deputized Motorized Patrols & Barangay Tanods will be fielded to ensure the smooth flow of traffic.

The traffic map with traffic advisory is attached for your reference.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

- Implementation: This traffic scheme is to be implemented during peak hours: 6A.M. 8A.M. & 2P.M. 5P.M. Monday to Friday (and whenever there are major CSA activities).
- One-way Streets: Carissa Street (from Palm Avenue to Lumbang) & Lumbang Street (from Carissa to Pasay Road) will be one-way during the peak hours. All other streets are two-way. Vehicles coming from Cafumpang, Campanilla & Caballero are to take a right turn upon reaching Lumbang.
- Parking: Vehicles proceeding to CSA will only be allowed to park along portions of Carissa & Lumbang Streets campus side during peak hours (shaded areas on the street layout). Double parking will not be allowed anytime.
- Towing/No Parking Areas: Palm Avenue (from Cypress down to Palm Avenue Gate) and Carissa & Lumbang (except during the peak hours) are Towing/No Parking Areas.

- No blowing of horns: Motorists are enjoined not to blow their horns unnecessarily while inside the village.
- ✓ Enforcement: Village Motorized Patrols & Barangay Tanods are MMDA deputized Traffic Enforcers, and are authorized to issue Traffic Violation Receipts (TVRs), remove plate numbers for certain violations.
- ✓ Entry for vehicles: Vehicles proceeding to CSA will be allowed entry starting 6 A.M. Monday to Friday. Vehicles with DVA-CSA stickers can access Palm Avenue, Pasay Road, Amorsolo & Lumbang gates. Vehicles without DVA-CSA stickers can access only at Palm Avenue & Pasay gates.
- Entry beyond 7 P.M.: All vehicles proceeding to CSA after 7 P.M. will be subject to gate procedures and can only access the Palm Avenue & Pasay Road gates.
