### THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS' REPORT

As another year in Dasmarinas Village history comes to an end, we would like to recount the ways in which we have wholeheartedly served the Dasmarinas Village Association. All our efforts have been aimed at preserving the peace, safety and security of Dasmarinas Village, this place we call HOME.

The year 2004 has seen the Board of Governors:

- Continuously give priority and primacy to Village security, the residents'
  safety and traffic concerns with the institution of security and safety
  enhancing programs, the deputization of the Village Security Officer to
  issue official violation receipts (OVR) for violations of the Makati City
  Traffic Code and the assignment of additional traffic patrols during peak
  hours within the vicinity of Colegio San Agustin (CSA). Further, the Board
  has been engaging in a constant dialogue with CSA authorities in order to
  jointly address and resolve the perennial problem of traffic and
  unauthorized parking in the areas surrounding CSA.
- Collect 98.7% of Association Dues.
- Implement programs to improve the Village's water generation and sewage facilities to assure the uninterrupted supply of water to residents.
- Pursue the continued implementation of the Village's Solid Waste Management System and the conduct of regular pest control programs throughout the Village to assure the cleanliness of the Village.
- Encourage community based events such as the holding of the second Manila Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) concert on November 5, 2004 at the DVA Pavillion featuring the 70-member orchestra and guest artists.
- Purchase additional equipment for the fitness gym to accommodate the increasing number of users.
- Embark on the rehabilitation of the 20-year old basketball/badminton court through the installation of a new TARAFLEX resilient synthetic PVC cushioned floor and modern scoring equipment.
