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TREE PRESERVATION PROJECT

VISION: A Village in Harmony with Nature

It was almost 4 years ago when Dasmarinas Village embarked on a Tree Preservation Project. This year, the DVA Board of Governors deemed it necessary to implement the same project again and decided to employ the services of Dr. Vicente L. Saplala to assist us in achieving our vision of "A Village in Harmony with Nature". Dr. Saplala holds a Ph.D. in Entomology and is a retired professor from the U.P. College of Forestry.

The main thrusts of this project are the following:

1. Remove dead primary and secondary tree branches,
2. Remove live and/or dead protruding stumps of branches,
3. Remove weak or dying branches,
4. Cut down/remove dead trees, and
5. Place identification plates on representative trees for information and educational purposes.

This project will be implemented in several phases. Phase I will include the trees at the following locations:
