DVA RFID Vehicle Access System

Dear Residents/Members:

Simultaneous with the issuance of the 2012-2013 car stickers which started on May 21, 2012, DVA will implement the RFID Vehicle Access System, a joint project of the four (4) Makati villages with existing inter-village vehicle access agreement.

The Four Makati Inter-Village or MIVA that are included in the RFID system are Forbes Park, Dasmariñas Village, Urdaneta Village, and Bel-Air Village. These four (4) villages have an estimated 35,500 registered vehicles. All these vehicles are allowed road access to every member village. Due to the large volume of vehicular traffic, this system will help our security force effectively screen incoming vehicles. This will add another layer of security for our residents. In addition, this will control the proliferation of fake MIVA stickers which is a constant security risk with the old system.

The RFID system, aims to provide a solution to these problems as well as improve the implementation of control over vehicles that are only authorized to pass.

Radio frequency identification (RFID) is a technology that uses radio waves to transfer data from an electronic tag, called RFID tag attached to an object, through a recorder for the purpose of identifying and tracking the object.

The use of this RFID technology is a relatively new experience so it is possible that we will encounter some technical glitches and other concerns, such as:

- · Scanner does not recognize the tag caused by:
 - 1. Car's plate number has not yet been encoded in the system.
 - 2. Tag is damaged.
 - 3. Car's non-metallic tint was changed to metallic.
- Scanner reads a negative response caused by:
 - 1. Car's plate number has not yet been encoded in the system.
 - Car is not allowed at the gate. Example: DVA Limited sticker will be recognized in our gates but not in the gates of the other 3 villages because said limited sticker was programmed as such.
- If the RFID tag is damaged, bring it to the DVA office immediately for replacement.

We enjoin you to report to DVA office immediately any concern or problem you observe on our RFID Vehicle Access System.

In the system that we installed, only the vehicle plate number will be identified and recorded to preserve the confidentiality of the vehicle owner.
