TRAFFIC SCHEME DURING SCHOOLDAYS

Dear Residents:

The DVA Board, during its regular meeting held in May, and upon the recommendation of the Security, Safety & Traffic Committee, approved a resolution regarding the implementation of the same traffic scheme that was used last year starting on the opening of classes at Colegio San Agustin (CSA). The entry of additional CSA vehicles within the Village may cause inconvenience to our residents. We are, therefore, seeking your kind understanding and patience on this matter. We advise that you avoid taking the streets near CSA and to take alternate routes instead.

Attached is a drawing of the traffic scheme which will be implemented on JUNE 13, 2012, MONDAY TO FRIDAY, from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM and from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM, AND DURING EARLY DISMISSAL/MAJOR EVENTS OF CSA.

Some features of this scheme are:

- CSA vehicles shall be allowed to pass through ONLY along Pasay Road (from the gate to Palm Avenue), Palm Avenue (from the gate to CSA), Lumbang (from Carissa to Pasay Road and exiting to Lumbang gate), Amorsolo (from the gate to Palm Avenue) and Carissa (from Palm Avenue to Lumbang). Refer to shaded portions in said drawing.
- Palm Avenue (from Magnolia to Carissa) will be one-way and so is Carissa (from Palm Avenue to Lumbang).
- Some street intersections near CSA will be closed using traffic cones, barboom or security guard to prevent CSA vehicles from passing through said streets.
- CSA vehicles are not allowed to park or loiter along Village streets any time and violators apprehended will be fined/penalized.
