Dear Residents,

Greetings!

The Board of Governors has observed various species of plants on our planting strip along the sidewalks. Whereas, "planting strip" is referred to as that portion of the right-of-way behind the curb line and between the curb line and the sidewalk or between the sidewalk and the right-of-way line used for the planting of trees, grass, or ground covers.

Board Resolution B.G. No. 2006-552 states in part that;

****Resolution B.G. No. 2006-552 effective January 19, 2007***

"All sidewalks shall conform to the existing finish of sidewalk level in accordance with DVA standards and specifications. No sidewalks or parts thereof shall be touched without the prior approval of DVA".

In light of your Board of Governors' constant endeavor in improving the Village, the Association affirmed to limit the number trees on the planting strip to its current number and allow only certain species of ground covers such as peanut plant and grass that can be planted on it. The Association will also conduct sidewalk improvement and beautification by planting grass in front of vacant lots.
