NEW TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS AT PASAY ROAD GATE

Dear Residents:

For the purpose of attaining efficiency, in terms of operating cost and traffic management, the DVA Board of Governors approved a resolution during its regular meeting held on October 29, 2015 and in the Security, Safety and Traffic Committee meeting held on November 9, 2015 wherein the following changes in our Village traffic rules and regulations shall be implemented effective ten (10) days from the date of this circular:

- Vehicular <u>ENTRY</u> at Pasay Road/Paraiso Street is allowed only from 5:30 AM to 6:00 PM, MONDAY to SUNDAY. After 6:00 PM, all vehicles will pass through the Pasay Road auxiliary gate. This will translate to an annual savings of ₱198,000.00 which we can use for other worthwhile projects.
- Vehicular <u>EXIT</u> at Pasay Road/Paraiso Street will be closed during rush hours from 7:00 AM to 10:00 AM and from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM, MONDAY to FRIDAY. During this period, all vehicles will exit through Pasay Road only. This will address the bottleneck created in this area which contributes to the slowdown of exiting vehicles at Pasay Road. Removing said bottleneck will help ensure a faster turnover of exiting vehicles.
- Continued implementation of the <u>NO PEDESTRIAN ACCESS</u> at Pasay Road (PETRON SIDE). For safety reasons, residents and guests shall access at the pedestrian lane which is designed for such purpose and is located at the other side of Pasay Road.
- Enforce the <u>NO-TURN</u> policy at Pasay Road/EDSA from 5:30 AM to 10:00 PM daily also for safety reasons.

The Board likewise approved the implementation of an automated vehicular access system at the entry and exit portion of Pasay Road/Paraiso Street which will reduce our security cost by about \$\textit{P}396,000.00 a year.}

Our Village security personnel are given the authority to apprehend violators of the abovementioned traffic rules and regulations wherein a fine shall be imposed and paid for based on our existing DVA policy.

We enjoin the cooperation of everyone in ensuring the smooth implementation of these rules and regulations.
