D.V.A. Circular No. 2016 – 08

Dear Residents:

During the past twelve days, there have been an alarming number of unexplained disappearances/deaths of cats within our village: Three (3) cats from our park cattery, three (3) park cats and eight (8) dead and missing cats along the Calumpang, Avocado and Paraiso streets. - some of these cats subsequently found dead. None of these cats died of natural causes. In the latest horrific instance, paint thinner was cruelly poured over the cat who died a slow and painful death from chemical burns.

An elderly family retainer who kindly feeds and waters the neutered cats for the past forty (40) years received the 2nd letter threat in his vehicle on January 18, 2016 in the Avocado-Paraiso area. The reproduced written threat is attached.

We call everyone's attention to the Republic Act 8485 and the amended IRR 10631 which provides fines up to Php 250,000.00 and imprisonment of up to three (3) years; and subsequent immediate deportation (if a foreigner) for acts of abuse, maltreatment, cruelty and neglect of animals.

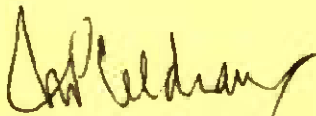
But, of greater concern to Dasmarinas Village residents is the realization that we have in our midst – neighbors and/or household staff and/or service personnel who are capable of acts of cruelty towards animals. Most of these cats have been neutered through a twelve (12) year program with CARA and actually serve the community as natural rodent and vermin control.

Both DVA personnel and security have been authorized/deputized to apprehend any person caught or suspected of causing harm to animals – whether resident, household staff or service personnel. We appeal to all residents, their dependents and household staff to please report any incidence of cruelty to animals or suspicion thereof immediately to the office of the Village Manager at the DVA offices on Campanilla Street.

Dear Residents:

Sa nakalipas na labindalawang araw, may mga insidente at hindi maipaliwanag na pagkawala at pagkamatay ng mga pusa sa loob ng ating village: 3 pusa mula sa loob ng park cattery, 3 pusa sa park at 8 pusa ang nawawala sa kahabaan ng mga kalye ng Calumpang, Avocado at Paraiso. Ang ilan sa mga nasabing pusa ay natagpuang patay na. Wala kahit isa man sa mga pusang ito ang namatay sa natural na dahilan. Isa sa mga pusa ay binuhusan pa ng paint thinner na nagresulta sa pagkasunog ng balat at naging sanhi ng pagkamatay nito.

May isang insidente rin kamakailan kung saan isang may edad na lalaki na apatnapung taon na nagpapa-kain sa mga pusa sa loob ng village ang nakatanggap ng dalawang sulat pagba-banta noong ika-18 ng Enero, 2016 sa area ng Avocado-Paraiso. Ang nabanggit na sulat pagba-banta ay naka-attached.

Gusto naming ipabatid sa lahat na may umiiral na batas - THE AMENDED ANIMAL WELFARE ACT RA 10631, na nagmumulta ng halagang PhP 250,000.00 at pagkaka-kulong sa loob ng 3 taon at kasunod na pagpapa-deport (kung foreigner o banyaga) sa mga taong mang-aabuso, magma-maltrato, mananakit at magpapabaya sa mga hayop – o ang magkait ng kalinga, pagkain at tirahan.

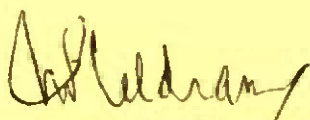
Subalit ang pinaka-mahalagang alalahanin sa lahat ng residente ng Dasmariñas Village ay ang katotohanang mayroong isa sa atin na may kakayahang manakit at pumatay ng mga hayop. Karamihan sa mga pusang ito ay wala ng kakayahang mag-anak (neutered) dahil sa labindalawang taong programa ng CARA (Compassion And Responsibility for Animals). Nakatutulong pa ang mga pusang ito upang kontrolin ang pagdami ng mga daga.
