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Good news!

Our partner telecommunications service providers – namely Sky, PLDT/Smart, and Globe – have given their commitment to fully migrate all their remaining subscribers to our newly-built Underground Fiber Network. As we speak, most of our residents already enjoy the benefits of this facility, and we thank those who have already completed their migration process.

In the coming months, our current aerial facilities will be pulled down. We want to ensure that all subscribers have transferred to the new underground facilities.

Why do we want to migrate to the Underground Fiber facility?

The Underground Fiber facility provides the best connectivity services that are fast, reliable, and sufficient to serve the needs of its residents.

What will happen if you do not migrate to the Underground Fiber facility?

If a residence does not migrate to the Underground Fiber facility, the household will be severely inconvenienced once the aerial cables are removed.

What needs to be done to migrate to the Underground Fiber facility?

We have agreed with the service providers to conduct migration activities starting November 04, 2022, as follows:

- 1. The telcos will conduct actual home visits to subscribers to conduct a pre-survey of the residence and assure its readiness.
- 2. The telcos' contractors will be available on-site to complete the immediate transfer of facilities.
- 3. The schedule the migration activities per cluster is specified below:
